AQUATIC CENTER SAFETY RULES

Mandated by the Oregon Health Authority and the City of Medford



All swimmers MUST have a cleansing shower BEFORE entering the pool *OR* AFTER using the bathroom.



IN POOL:

- No food or drink, with the exception of water, in the pool.
- No glass containers.
- No horseplay, inappropriate touching or public displays of affection.
- Large inflatable water toys are prohibited.
- No prolonged, competitive, repetitive breath-holding.
- Persons who have had active diarrhea or other communicable diseases in the past 14 days are prohibited.
- Immuno-compromised individuals should use caution when using the pool.
- Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs are prohibited.
- All swimmers must wear an appropriate swimsuit. Loose shirts should be secured.
- Swimmers with open sores, wounds, bandages are prohibited.
- Swimmers who are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper.
- Water shoes are permitted.
- U.S Coast Guard approved life jackets only.
- Diving is permitted in depths greater than 6'6".
- LIFEGUARDS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO SWIM TEST ANY PERSON THAT APPEARS TO BE A NON-SWIMMER.

LAZY RIVER ONLY:


- Do not go against the current.
- Do not climb or walk on the edge.

ON DECK:

- AED, First aid kit and phone for emergencies are located in the Lifeguard office.
- No running, horseplay, inappropriate touching, or public displays of affection.
- No glass containers.
- No food or gum in the natatorium.
- No beverages, with the exception of water, near pool.
- Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs are prohibited.
- Appropriate footwear, clean and free of debris.
- Only service animals in the natatorium.
- No smoking or vaping.
- Breastfeeding is permitted.

AGE AND NON-SWIMMER POLICY:

- Children 5 & under MUST be accompanied by a parent/ guardian in the water within arms reach at all times.
- Children 6 to 9 MUST have a parent/guardian in the natatorium at all times.
- Children 10 to 13 MUST have a parent/ guardian in the building at all times.
- Those who cannot pass the swim test are restricted to depths no greater than their armpits or MUST always have a parent/guardian in the water within arms reach.
- Those requiring the use of a flotation aid MUST always have a parent/guardian in the water within arms reach.



PLAY STRUCTURE ONLY:

Do not go down the slide headfirst.

OBEY THE LIFEGUARD AT ALL TIMES! | LIFE JACKETS AVAILABLE UPON REQUEST PERSONS WHO FAIL TO ADHERE TO THE RULES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE FACILITY *IMMEDIATELY*.
